

SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

This Settlement Agreement ("Agreement") is made and entered into on 1st February 2025, between:

- Dimitre977 (the "Plaintiff") represented by Solid Law
- kesballo (the "Defendant") represented by public defender BabySoga

Terms of Settlement

1. The Defendant agrees to compensate the Plaintiff as follows:

- \$20,000 in compensatory damages for the stolen drill.
- \$200 per hour from the time of theft until the \$20,000 is fully paid, representing lost revenue.
- 30% of the total amount owed (compensatory damages + lost revenue) to cover legal fees.

2. The Plaintiff agrees to waive all legal claims related to this matter upon full payment.

3. This Agreement constitutes an admission of liability and guilt by the Defendant.

Payment Terms

- Payment shall be fined by the DOJ, and the defendant shall be put into treasury debt for the full amount not covered by their balance.
- Failure to meet payment obligations may result in further legal action.

Jurisdiction and Arbitration

This agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Redmont. Any disputes arising under or in connection with this agreement shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Redmont. All disputes under this agreement are subject to legal action, and the prevailing party shall be entitled to legal fees. Breach of contract by the party who shall cause damages in any shape or form shall be subject to provide remedy in a Court of law in the form of monetary compensation.

Both parties agree to make all reasonable attempts to settle disputes arising under this contract before pursuing legal action against the lender.

Scope of Agreement

This agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties with respect to the subject matter hereof and supersedes all prior or contemporaneous agreements, understandings, or representations, whether written or oral. All provisions of this contract hereby take ultimate effect as of the date and exact time of the signatures of both parties.
